Lunch Supervision Program

Grade 4-6 students will remain on school property during the lunch hour. They will eat lunch in their classroom. Parents have been asked to complete the annual Demographic Form to indicate if their child will go home for lunch daily.

Grades 7 & 8 may leave the school site during lunch hour if parents indicate this on the demographic form. This is a privilege for our older students and we expect a high standard of conduct whilst students are downtown as they continue to represent our school. This privilege may be re-evaluated as the year progresses as we want to be mindful of the number of our students flooding the core of our town with no supervision.
